

Current Students Considering Taking AP Courses in the Future

In many cases, it is okay if students haven't completed 10- or 20-level Cohort AP prerequisite courses!

Strong students in the regular streams are usually well prepared!



Art Drawing/Sculpting AP:

- Completion of Art 10 and 20 (regular stream)
- Art drawing AP can be taken year-long in Grade 12

Biology AP:

- Strong understanding of, and interest in biology unit of Science 10 (regular stream)
- Biology AP can be taken year-long (with Bio 20 and 30) in Grades 11 (preferred) or 12

Calculus AB:

- Excellent performance in Math 10C and 20-1 (regular stream)
- Calculus AB can be taken year-long (with Math 30-1 and 31); Grade 12 preferred

Chemistry AP:

- Excellent performance in Chemistry 20 (regular stream)
- Chemistry AP can be taken year-long (with Chem 30) in Grades 11 or 12 (preferred)

Chinese AP:

- Chinese 20-6Y completed prior to start of Sem. 2
- Chinese AP is a second semester course

Computer Science A AP:

- Completion of Computer Science 10 and 20
- Computer Science AP can be taken year-long in Grade 12

English Literature AP:

- Excellent performance in ELA 20
- Students complete ELA 30/35 (10 credits) in one semester (second semester)

European History AP:

- Solid performance in Social Studies 10-1 (regular stream)
- European History AP is taken year-long (as part of Social 20-1) in Grade 11

Physics AP:

- Strong performance in Science 10 (regular stream)
- Physics AP (along with Physics 20) is taken first semester of Grade 11 or 12

Psychology AP:

- No prerequisite
- Psychology 20-AP Cohort is good preparation

Spanish Language AP:

- Spanish 20-9Y completed prior to start of Sem. 2
- Spanish Language AP is a second semester course

French Language AP:

- French 20-9Y completed prior to start of Sem. 2
- French Language AP is a second semester course
