#### **Terminology:**



AP Course: A class (often Grade 12) leading to an AP Exam

AP-cohort Course: A class (often Grade 10 or 11) which is enriched and leads to an AP course

- These courses are:
  - Art-Drawing/Sculpting
  - Biology
  - European History
  - Calculus AB
  - Chemistry
  - Computer Science A
  - Computer Science Principles (run as a club in 24-25)
  - Chinese (Sem 2)
  - Spanish Language (Sem 2)
  - English Lit (Sem 2)
  - Physics 1 (Sem 1 only)
  - Psychology (Sem 2)

- Year-long/Sem 1 courses began in Sept
- Sem 2 courses begin in Feb 2025
- Cost of each AP exam is \$150 (payable via PowerSchool account)
  - Year-long/Sem 1 courses: Due Nov. 1
  - Sem 2 courses due early March

AP Exams (and portfolios) are written in May

If a student is enrolled in an AP course but wants to opt out of writing the AP exam:

For a full refund, students indicate this to me by Nov. 1

 Any time prior to day of exam: Refund minus \$60 as late fee (paid to College Board)



#### **AP Exams**

Scores are reported in early July on College Board's myAP site

 Students may indicate which colleges and universities should receive score reports

 A grade of 4 or 5 (out of 5) is generally enough to receive university course credit at most Canadian universities

- Mon May 5 Biology (8am)
- Mon May 5 European History (12pm)
- Tues May 6 Chemistry (8am)
- Weds May 7 English Lit (8am)
- Weds May 7 Comp Sci A (12pm)
- Fri May 9 Chinese (12pm)

- Fri May 9 Art portfolios due (6pm)
- Mon May 12 Calculus AB/BC (8am)
- Tues May 13 Physics 2 (12pm)
- Fri May 23 Physics 1 (8am)
- Fri May 23 Spanish Language (8am)
- Fri May 23 Psychology (12pm)
- Fri May 23 Comp Sci Principles(12pm)

  - Note: You must be currently enrolled or have completed Math 30-1/31AP
- Computer Science Principles Fri May 23 @ 12pm
- English Language and Composition Weds May 14 @ 8am
- Microeconomics Mon May 5 @ 12pm
- Macroeconomics Fri May 9 @ 12pm
- Physics 2 Tues May 13 @ 12pm

Students should see Mr. Rubin in Rm 2208 prior to Nov. 1 if they'd like to challenge any of these exams
