Students will be assigned to a **Graduation Group Number** with a **Teacher Supervisor** that they will need to remember for the graduation rehearsal and ceremony. This information will be posted by Friday May 9, 2025 on a large bulletin board by the cafeteria.

Graduation Ceremony Rehearsal (at Ernest Manning High School): Monday May 12, 2025 from 12:30 PM – 3:30 PM

Please DO NOT bring any belongings to the rehearsal as there is limited space. Please place belongings in your locker or vehicle.

- PURPOSE: Practice the processional, review important graduation information, and pick up graduation gowns and caps. MANDATORY attendance for all graduating students.
- At 12:30 PM, students will be called down to Main Street. Please locate your
 Group Number and Teacher Supervisor on Main Street. Teacher supervisors will have a large sign identifying their group number.
- Please follow the directions from the teacher supervisor. Students will line up alphabetically in their groups. When the processional rehearsal begins, students will make their way to the Main Gymnasium. Please remain standing until the MC indicates that you may be seated.
- Once all students are seated, the graduation ceremony & banquet organizers will proceed with a Graduation Information PowerPoint that will cover important information for both events.
- After the rehearsal is complete, students will proceed to the Auxiliary Gymnasium to pick up their graduation gowns, stoles, and caps. Students MUST remember to bring these items to the ceremony for May 14, 2025. Students without a gown will not be able to participate.

CEREMONY TICKETS

Ceremony tickets are free, however, due to venue capacity, there is a limit of **6 tickets per family**. Graduands do not need a ticket. Tickets are required to enter the BMO for the ceremony. Should a family require additional tickets, there will be a few extra seats that will be distributed through a lottery. Please make your requests for extra tickets on the ticket order form. Ticket order forms will be distributed on April 1, 2025 and to be returned to the main office by April 15, 2025, no later than 4:00 PM.

Important to Note: On the ticket order forms, there is a section where families will be able to indicate if accessibility seating is required for family members with wheelchairs or walkers. Any ceremony ticketing concerns should be addressed to: Ms. Lam-Szalay at hmlamszalay@cbe.ab.ca

CEREMONY ATTIRE

The event is semi-formal, and we encourage graduands to dress appropriately. Students must wear their gown, stole and hat to cross the stage. Please leave items like jackets, purses and cellphones with family or friends to avoid leaving them behind in the line-up area. We do not have the ability to offer a secure storage place for these items and these items will not be allowed to be taken with you into the ceremony. The school does not assume responsibility for the security of any student items.

This is an event where your loved ones, family, friends, teachers, peers, and community will formally recognize and celebrate your success. The ceremony will take place at the BMO Centre on May 14, 2025, from 9:00 AM - 11:30 AM GRADUATES, PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY TO ARRIVE ON TIME.

- 8:00 am | All graduands arrive at the BMO Centre and in their proper ceremony attire, with gown, stole, and hat on. Follow the directions of the teacher supervisors once arrived.

- 11:30 am | Recessional begins
- 11:30 am 12:30 pm | Photo opportunities with family and friends
- 12:30 pm | Hall closes

BANQUET ATTIRE AND ETIQUETTE

- Student dress is formal or semi-formal. Both long dresses and cocktail dresses are appropriate. Tuxedos, suits or jackets and dress pants are also appropriate.
- There is a complimentary coat check located outside of the hall.
- This is a buffet dinner reception.
- No alcohol is permitted at the BMO Centre.
- All student, guest, and parent bags will be searched upon entry to the banquet area.
- Please be respectful of the BMO Centre security staff (it is their job to search all bags).
- Once guests have entered the banquet area they are required to remain inside.
- Re-entry is not permitted for students.
- Parents and/or guardians may re-enter; however, bags will be checked upon reentry.

When purchasing tickets if there are any allergies not identified above, please identify this in the drop-down tab at the time of purchase. Please note that allergy meals are tailored specifically to guests that have allergic reactions.

PURCHASING BANQUET TICKETS

- Ticket cost: \$120.00 per banquet ticket
- Everyone entering the graduation banquet requires a ticket
- Grad banquet tickets are ordered online through your MyCBE PowerSchool Parent account in the fee section
- To purchase Banquet tickets students must also have all school fees paid in full.
 PowerSchool will not allow tickets to be purchased if fees have not been paid.

Round 1 of Banquet Ticket Sales | will go on sale on Tuesday, April 1, 2025 at 5:00 PM, and are on sale until Tuesday April 15, 2025 at 4:00 PM.

 Each graduand may purchase, if desired, a total of 8 tickets at this time (one for the graduand plus 7 guests)

Round 2 of Banquet Ticket Sales | Tuesday, April 15, 2025 at 5:00 PM, to Tuesday April 22, 2025 at 11:00 PM.

- No limit on extra ticket purchases while supplies last.
- 6. NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AFTER Tuesday April 22, 2025 at 11:00 PM. Sorry, NO EXCEPTIONS.

You must complete FOUR steps in order to ensure a place at the Graduation Banquet and Dance:

- 1. Order your tickets online at https://sis.cbe.ab.ca/public/home.html
- 2. Choose table seating online.
- 3. Pay for tickets (online by credit card or Interac).
- 4. Pick up Banquet Tickets on assigned day by last name.

Family members will have access to Round 1 of ticket sales in PowerSchool beginning at 5:00 PM on Tuesday April 1, 2025. You will be able to select your table (tables seat 8 with some tables of 10). Tables cannot be reserved for later purchase. Therefore, it may not be possible for guests to sit together if their tickets are purchased at separate times. Because of this, it is advised to purchase all your tickets at one time.

How do I order my Grad Banquet tickets?

To access the online ticketing system, you will need to access PowerSchool Payments.

- 1. Choose Graduation Ticket
- 2. Enter the number of tickets you want to order, and your name and contact information (including a valid email address).
- 3. Add your guest names.
- 4. Enter dietary restrictions and/or accessible seating needs, if any.

Entrance to the Banquet

Physical Banquet tickets will be issued by the school based on purchases through MyCBE PowerSchool account. Tickets can be picked up at school on the same days that Ceremony tickets will be picked up. (see page 3)

Please make sure that you bring the tickets with you the evening of the event. Once students have entered the venue, there will be no re-entry.

For groups wanting to be seated together:

- Tables seat parties of 8 with some tables of 10 people.
- It is up to the graduands to choose their seats using the online system.
- If graduands wish to sit at the same and/or adjacent tables they will be able to view a map of all available seats/tables at the time of booking.
- Students are responsible for choosing where they sit and whom they sit with.
- Once seats have been chosen, they cannot be changed.
- Please be advised that tickets purchased during the period of April 15 April 22, if available, have limited seating available.
